Buzz's Behavior

When shod:

- Nervous and antsy when going far from other horses
- Occasionally resistant to picking up feet when distracted by the environment
- Becomes so nervous and panicked with where his friends are that he tries to rear, especially while the shoes are being nailed in. Improving with each farrier visit

When blanketed:

- Tosses head as it is put over his back
- Acts like he's going to nip you when attaching the chest straps, but never has

When girthed:

• Fine, may toss head

When saddled:

• Fine

When bridled/haltered:

• Good, occasionally acts sleepy to try and get out of working

Vices:

Weaving

Turnout:

- Needs to be with other horses
- Can be left outdoors in any weather, as long as he is blanketed appropriately

Sensitivity to new feed/hay

• Adapts to different feeds easily, but needs to be on very high quality feed in order to maintain weight

Behavior during feeding:

• Safe, but loses body awareness and may hit you with his head or step on you
