Required Teaching Policy

To insure that all WVPC members will gain experience with teaching, members will be expected to present information to the group regarding skills and topics at their rating level or above throughout the year.

D1-D2

- Will gain additional experiences within the Badge Program
Will assist a C1 or above, when asked, to help with at least one unmounted lesson

D3

- Will learn how to conduct safety checks with supervision on D1-D2 members
Will teach at least one (1) simple D1-2 unmounted lesson

C1

- Will conduct safety checks on D1-D3 members with supervision
- Will teach unmounted lessons to D1-D2 members
- Will begin to develop written lesson plans with assistance
- Will practice helping D level members to prepare for Turn-out

C2

- Will have opportunities to assist instructors by teaching a single skill during mounted instruction while being mentored by an instructor
- Will teach unmounted topics with upper level or adult supervision to D1-D3 members
- Will develop written lesson plans and discuss it with an appropriate instructor

HB/C3

- Will teach unmounted lessons to D1-C2 members
- Will teach mounted lessons to 1 to 3 riders while being supervised by an instructor

B

- Will teach unmounted and mounted lessons to members on a regular basis
- Will assist as needed in camps, prep clinics, etc
- Will be able to evaluate lesson plan used, their own or others

HA/A

- Will teach unmounted and mounted lessons to a single member or in groups up to 5 members
- Will be a leader and resource to the club and with camps, prep clinics, etc
